- Y4 Unsporting Behaviour – Breaking up a promising opposition attack
- Y5 Encroachment when play is restarted with a free kick, corner kick or throw in
- Y6 Shows dissent by word
- Y7 Shows dissent by gesture
- Y8 Persistently infringing the Laws of the Game
- Y9 Delaying the restart of play
- Y10 Acts in a manner which shows lack of respect for the game
- Y11 Entering the field of play without the referee's permission
- Y12 Leaving the field of play without the referee's permission
- Y13 Unsporting Behaviour – Simulation
- Y14 Use a deliberate kick to pass the ball to his goalkeeper to circumvent the Law
- Y15 Unsporting action after scoring a goal
- Y16 Unsporting behaviour by a substitute
- Y17 Dissent by a substitute
- Y18 Delaying the restart of play by a substitute
- Y19 Provoking a confrontation by deliberately touching the ball after the referee has stopped play
